SUBJECT:

Notice of Intent to Develop DOE N 470.X, *Implementation of Section 1072 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2008*

PURPOSE:

Department of Energy (DOE) N 470.X will serve to implement the provisions of the above-cited section of the National Defense Authorization Act, commonly referred to as the Bond Amendment. The Bond Amendment sets forth certain new requirements for agencies in granting access to sensitive compartmented information, special access programs, or restricted data.

JUSTIFICATION:

Implementation of the Public Law is mandatory throughout the Executive Branch, as soon as possible, and cannot wait for the revisions to DOE M 470.4-5, *Personnel Security* to become effective.

Contents of DOE N 470.X will be incorporated into the updated version of DOE M 470.4-5, *Personnel Security*, now under development.

The proposed directive does not duplicate existing laws, regulations or national standards and it does not create undue burden on the Department. Therefore, we are requesting a processing time of 30 days (Track 1).

IMPACT:

Impact will be limited to site personnel security offices and the Office of Departmental Personnel Security. It is anticipated that the implementation of the Bond Amendment in the manner described in DOE N 470.X will result in a negligible impact upon resources.
