SUBJECT: Notice of Intent to Develop a New Continuity
Programs Order

PURPOSE: To establish Policy and Responsibilities for the
Department of Energy Continuity Programs.

JUSTIFICATION: Continuity planning is required by Presidential
Decision Directive-67 (PDD-67), Enduring
Constitutional Government and Continuity of
Government Operations, Executive Order 12656,
Assignment of Emergency Preparedness
Responsibilities, and Executive Order 12472,
Assignment of National Security and Emergency
Preparedness Telecommunications Functions,
3 April 1984 (revised 28 February 2003). PDD-67
established a comprehensive program designed to
ensure survival of our constitutional form of
government and continuity of essential federal
functions. The program centers around three
fundamental policy concepts: Enduring
Constitutional Government (ECG), Continuity of
Government (COG), and Continuity of Operations
(COOP).

We are requesting a processing time of 120 days
(track 4) for this Order and have attached a
proposed development schedule.

IMPACT: The cost impact is expected to be extensive since this is a new directive.
