**SUBJECT: ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP (ARG)**

---

1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE O 154.1 (formerly DOE 5530.1A), ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP, dated September 20, 1991, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and its contractors. Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Order.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORIG 5530.1A, ACCIDENT RESPONSE GROUP (ARG), dated November 15, 1994.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this Chapter are applicable to ORO Principal Staff and management and operating contractors.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
  - a. Manager, Emergency Management Program Office (MEMPO).
    - (1) Performs those tasks identified in DOE O 154.1, subparagraph 8k.
    - (2) Coordinates formulation, maintenance, and implementation of plans and procedures for response by ORO and ORO contractors to a nuclear weapons accident or significant incident.
  - b. Principal Staff.
    - (1) Under whose supervision procurement requests are initiated, perform those tasks identified in DOE O 154.1, subparagraphs 8l and m.
    - (2) As requested by the MEMPO, perform those tasks identified in DOE O 154.1, subparagraphs 8j(1) and (2).
  - c. Contracting Officers' Representatives (COR), as requested by the MEMPO, perform those tasks identified in DOE O 154.1, subparagraphs 8j(2) and (3).

**CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT**

Contractors that are identified in paragraph 3 of this Chapter shall accomplish the following:

1. When requested by the COR, develop procedures and provide personnel and equipment to support the ARG.
2. Maintain the Radiation Emergency Assistance Center/Training Site (REAC/TS) and, when requested by the MEMPO, provide medical assistance to the ARG (Oak Ridge Associated Universities only).
3. Implement the DOE Radiological Assistance Program Region 2 response plans and procedures to support an ARG deployment when requested by the MEMPO (Lockheed Martin Energy Systems, Inc., only).
