**SUBJECT: FEDERAL RADIOLOGICAL MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT CENTER (FRMAC)**

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1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE 5530.5, FEDERAL RADIOLOGICAL MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT CENTER, dated July 10, 1992, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and its contractors. Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Directive.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 150, Chapter VI, Chg. 1, FEDERAL RADIOLOGICAL MONITORING AND ASSESSMENT CENTER (FRMAC), dated July 24, 1998.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this Chapter apply to ORO Principal Staff and to contractors to the extent set forth in their contract.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
  - a. Leader, Emergency Management Team (EMT).
    - (1) Performs those tasks identified in DOE 5530.5, subparagraph 8g.
    - (2) Forwards requests for FRMAC support to the DOE Headquarters Emergency Operations Center (EOC).
    - (3) Ensures that the Region 2 Radiological Assistance Program (RAP) supports a FRMAC deployment, when requested.
    - (4) Ensures that the Radiation Emergency Assistance Center/Training Site (REAC/TS) is maintained in an operational state of readiness and that, when requested, REAC/TS provides medical assistance to the FRMAC when deployed.
  - b. Principal Staff, under whose supervision procurement requests are initiated, perform those tasks identified in DOE 5530.5, subparagraph 8k.
5. REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES. None.
6. REFERENCES. See ORO O 150, Chapter IV, Change 3, Radiological Assistance Program (RAP), dated February 8, 2001, and any subsequent revisions.
7. DEFINITIONS. None.

**CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT**

Contractors that are identified in paragraph 3 of this Chapter will accomplish the following, to the extent set forth in their contract:

1. When requested, and consistent with contractor responsibilities identified in ORO O 150, Chapter IV, Change 3, Radiological Assistance Program (RAP), dated February 8, 2001, support a Region 2 RAP deployment in support of a FRMAC.
2. Manage and maintain REAC/TS in an operational state of readiness and, when requested, provide medical support to a FRMAC deployment (Oak Ridge Associated Universities only).
3. Forward requests for FRMAC support through the ORO EOC.
