SUBJECT: SAFETY OF ACCELERATOR FACILITIES

1. PURPOSE This Chapter correlates to DOE O 420.2, SAFETY OF ACCELERATOR FACILITIES, dated November 5, 1998, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and its contractors. Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Order.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 420, Chapter III, Chg. 1, SAFETY OF ACCELERATOR FACILITIES, dated March 31, 1998.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this Chapter apply to ORO Principal Staff. Although the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) attached to DOE O 420.2 is applicable to contractors to the extent set forth in their contract, no additional requirements intended for contractors are imposed in this Chapter.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES. Many ORO contractors have developed Standards/Requirements Identification Documents (S/RIDs) or Work Smart Standards (WSS) sets that may not include requirements referenced or included in DOE O 420.2 or this Chapter. Interpretation and performance of Federal responsibilities outlined below must take into account the approved standards set for each particular contract and must not be deemed to add any requirements to the approved set.
 - a. Director, Operations Division.
 - (1) Provides guidance and technical assistance to the Contracting Officers' Representatives in their performance of tasks as described in subparagraph 4b of this Chapter.
 - (2) Provides independent review of contractor operation of accelerator facilities and safety documentation submitted to ORO, and transmits findings to the appropriate ORO line organization.
 - b. Contracting Officer's Representatives.

Perform those tasks identified in DOE O 420.2, subparagraph 5b.
