SUBJECT: RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT

1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE 5820.2A, RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT, dated September 26, 1988, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to the Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) and those contractors identified in paragraph 3 below. Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any DOE Order.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 430, Chapter IV, RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT, dated June 14, 1996.
3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions of this Chapter apply to ORO Principal Staff and to contractors and subcontractors performing work that involves management of waste containing radioactivity and/or radioactively contaminated facilities of DOE under the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, as required by law and/or contract.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES. Many ORO contractors have developed Standards/Requirements Identification Documents (S/RIDs) or Work Smart Standards (WSS) sets that may not include requirements referenced or included in DOE 5820.2A or this Chapter. Interpretation and performance of Federal responsibilities outlined below must take into account the approved standards set for each particular contract and must not be deemed to add any requirements to the approved set.
 - a. Assistant Manager for Environmental Management establishes waste management requirements for all waste generated under ORO jurisdiction and ensures that waste management and surplus facility operations comply with DOE 5820.2A and all applicable Federal, state, and local statutes.
 - b. Group Leader, Environmental Services Group, performs those tasks identified in DOE 5820.2A, subparagraphs 8j(4) and (5).
 - c. Contracting Officer's Representatives are responsible for those tasks listed in DOE 5820.2A, subparagraphs 8j(1), (3), (6)-(8), and (10).

CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT

Contractors identified in paragraph 3 of this Chapter will accomplish the following, to the extent set forth in their contract or as required by law:

1. Establish programs to minimize the generation of and manage the treatment, storage, transportation, and/or disposal of radioactive wastes, and the pollutants or hazardous substances they contain, in a manner that complies with all applicable Federal, state, and local environmental, safety, and health laws, regulations, and DOE requirements.
2. For management of high-level, transuranic, and/or low-level waste; management of waste containing naturally occurring and accelerator produced radioactive material; and/or decommissioning of radioactively contaminated facilities, develop programs that conform to DOE 5820.2A, Chapters I through V, paragraph 3, REQUIREMENTS.
