SUBJECT: WORKER PROTECTION

1. PURPOSE. This Order provides detailed requirements for Oak Ridge Operations (ORO) activities under Series 440, Worker Protection, by assigning responsibility, accountability and providing administrative and/or contractual guidance to ORO and its contractors.
2. SIGNIFICANT CHANGES. This Order incorporates as chapters in the 440 Series the current Oak Ridge directives listed in paragraph 3 below.
