SUBJECT: PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

1. PURPOSE. This Chapter correlates to DOE O 460.1B, PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION SAFETY, dated April 4, 2003, by assigning responsibility and accountability and providing administrative guidance to Oak Ridge Office (ORO) and the National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Y-12 Site Office (YSO). Nothing in this issuance changes any requirements contained in any Department of Energy (DOE) Directive.
2. CANCELLATION. This Chapter cancels and replaces ORO O 460, Chapter I, Change 4, PACKAGING AND TRANSPORTATION SAFETY, dated November 24, 2003.
3. APPLICABILITY. This Chapter is applicable to ORO and YSO Principal Staff. Although the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) attached to DOE O 460.1B is applicable to contractors, no additional contractor requirements are imposed in this Chapter. The NNSA YSO will determine the applicability of this ORO Directive to their programs. References to the YSO are to clarify the interface between ORO and YSO and are not intended to indicate direction to YSO by ORO. This guidance does not assign responsibility or authority for the YSO to ORO.
4. RESPONSIBILITIES.
 - a. Director, Safety and Health Division.
 - (1) Performs those tasks identified in DOE O 460.1B, Paragraphs 5c(3), (4), (6), and (7).
 - (2) Provides technical support to YSO, as requested.
 - b. Contracting Officer's Representatives (COR), ORO and YSO, perform those tasks identified in DOE O 460.1B, Paragraph 5c(1) and (5). The ORNL and Environmental Management COR is responsible for the review and approval of onsite transportation and safety documents and Quality Assurance Programs as specified in DOE O 460.1B, Paragraph 5c(2).
 - c. Y-12 Site Office performs those tasks identified in DOE O 460.1B, Paragraph 5c(1)-(7).
