Annex 26 Advanced Supermarket Refrigeration/Heat Recovery Systems

Annex objective

The objective of Annex 26 is to demonstrate and document the benefits of advanced systems design for food refrigeration and space heating and cooling for retail food stores (supermarkets). A specific goal is to identify advanced systems design options to reduce total equivalent warming impact (TEWI) of supermarkets.

Progress since last report

Final drafts of both the executive summary (Volume 1) and the individual country reports (Volume 2) for the Annex final report have been completed. The drafts have been fully reviewed within the Annex and forwarded to the Heat Pump Centre for publication. Volume 1 will be released to all interested persons upon publication. Volume 2 (detailed country reports) will be held within the Annex participating countries for one year after the Volume 1 report is issued. The operating agent is presently working on updating the Annex web site to include links to the Annex report. The site will include a password-protected area to be accessible only to persons from the participating countries for a period of one year after the Volume 1 report is published. It is planned to have the site linked to the HPC web site as well.
