## Research Isotope Request Form

*(Deadline for submission: July 23, 2004)*

The purpose of the NEPRI Research Isotope Request Form is to provide the U. S. Department of Energy (DOE) with the information it needs to better understand the needs of the research community, to know which isotopes are in demand during the coming fiscal year, and to learn what funding organizations are sponsoring the research. DOE regards this information as Business Sensitive, not for public consumption, and will not be disclosed. The information you provide will assist DOE as it optimizes production of research isotopes in the upcoming fiscal year and helps gauge future demand.

If you plan to order isotopes from the U.S. DOE during FY 2005 ( Oct. 1, 2004 through Sept. 30, 2005), then it is important that you complete the Research Isotope Request Form by July 23, 2004. If you are unsure whether you will need any or all of the isotopes you request during this time period, complete the Request Form regardless. If a specific isotope is not requested by you or anyone else, then there is no guarantee that it will be considered for production during Fiscal Year 2005.
