Technology Summary

The disclosure relates to computer security and more specifically to an apparatus and method for protecting a video monitor from unauthorized viewing. This technology provides absolute, provable privacy for the authorized viewer of a video monitor in any environment; private, public, or crowded room. No unauthorized view can determine any information that is clearly available to the authorized viewer. Stolen equipment cannot be used to view screens in alternative locations or in the same location at a later time.
